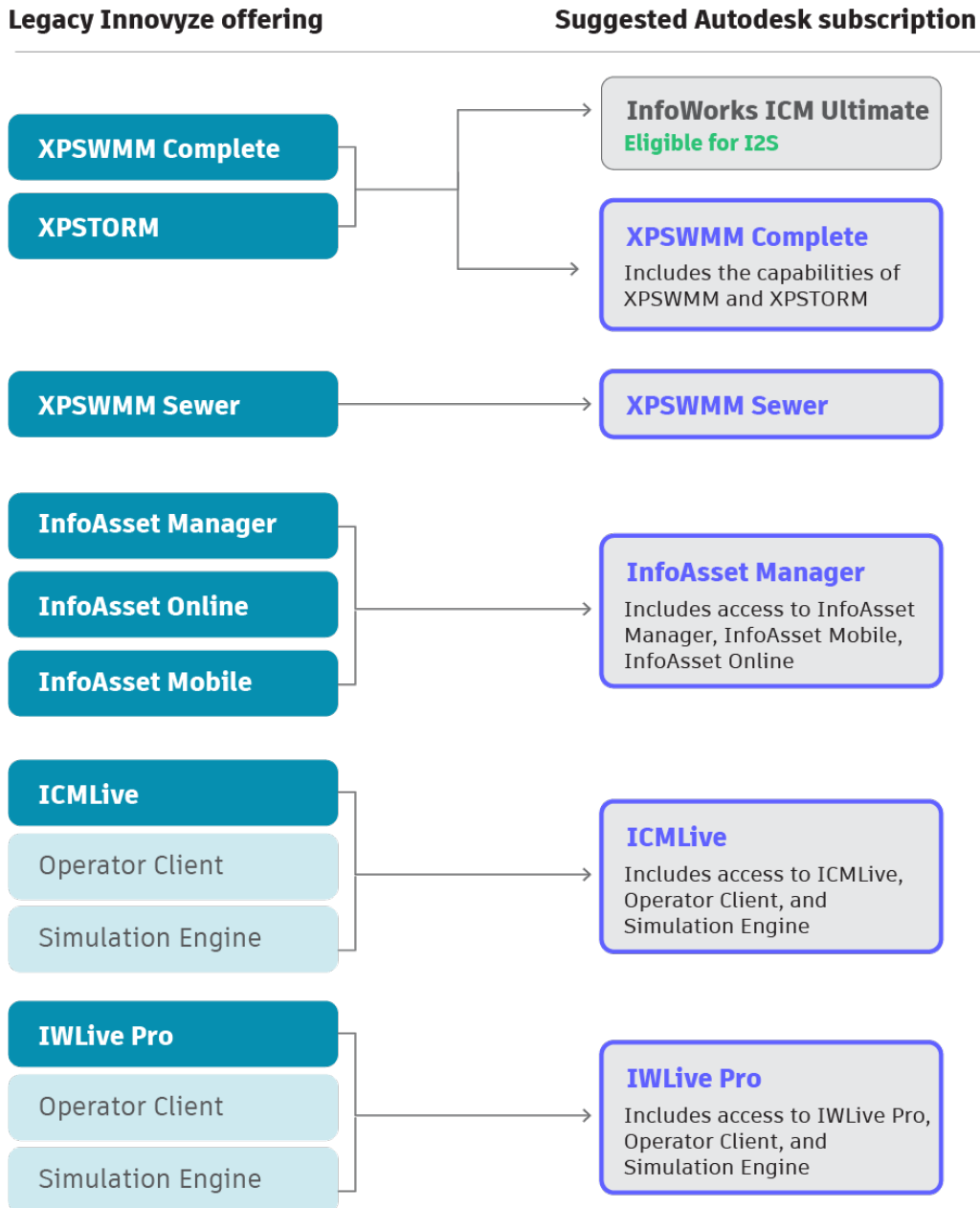


FAQ: New Autodesk subscriptions for XPSWMM, InfoAsset Manager, ICMLive, and IWLIVE Pro

What's happening?

Starting on April 7, 2025, we are making four industry-standard products from the former Innovyze portfolio available for purchase as an Autodesk subscription: XPSWMM, InfoAsset Manager, ICMLive, and IWLIVE Pro.





Why are we doing this?

While Autodesk is innovating quickly to serve the AECO industry with a cloud-connected, open data platform, we understand the water industry faces challenges with transitioning as quickly as technology evolves. Budgets are tight, and there is a shortage of digital skills in the industry. While innovation may be top of mind, and full digital transformation is always going to be the goal, adopting new systems and processes can take a back seat to maintaining crucial use cases. For most water utilities, it's the time-tested software and systems that are doing the real mission-critical work.

This is why we are extending the availability of XPSWMM, InfoAsset Manager, ICMLive, and IWLIVE Pro via flexible and scalable Autodesk subscription plans, to help our customers tackle every aspect of the water infrastructure asset lifecycle. Are these products eligible for the InfoCare to Subscription (I2S) program?

What does this mean for me as an existing Innovyze subscriber or customer on InfoCare?

Innovyze subscriptions and InfoCare renewals will no longer be available starting on May 7, 2025. After these dates, customers must choose one of the options outlined in this FAQ to move forward with an Autodesk subscription. We have taken great care with the new subscription plans to ensure they are as comparable in cost as possible to existing Innovyze licenses. I have an Enterprise Business Agreement, are there any special considerations?

Yes. If you have an existing Enterprise Business Agreement and an expiring InfoCare renewal or Innovyze Subscription for XPSWMM, InfoAsset Manager, ICMLive, and/or IWLIVE Pro, please reach out to your dedicated Autodesk representative. You will be able to add the new offerings to your existing Enterprise Business Agreement when your InfoCare renewal or Innovyze subscription expires.
